Print out the grid above on a sheet of card. Cut up the cards and shuffle them. The learner looks at the first sequence (e.g., N O -), names the first two letters, and gives the name of the missing letter. The learner works through all the cards in the pack. The alphabet arc acts as a prop as they can check if unsure. (Note that young children might need the cards enlarging and will perhaps only work on the first half of the alphabet or a short section of it.)
