1. How do I access the SAGE Instructor Teaching Site?

This error means you are trying to access an instructor page that is password protected. If you have an account, sign in with the approved email address and password. You will be directed to the instructor resources site. (If you are not registered with SAGE, please create an account.)

Error: The email address entered was not found. Please try again or create a new account with that email address.

If you have not created an account, please click on the 'New User' box.
