

### CONQUERING LITERACY ACTIVITY 19: SORTING CARDS c/k/ck (AP TP13)

Cut up the cards in the first grid and ask the learner to sort them into two sets (one beginning with 'c' and one beginning with 'k'). Support the learner in discovering the 'c/k' rule (see Main Programme TP42) by looking for a pattern in each set of words.

cat	kit	camp	cask
cot	cod	kip	kink
cab	king	Kent	cup
kept	keg	cast	cog

Cut up the cards in the second grid and ask the learner to sort them into three sets (-ck, -k, and -c). Support the learner in discovering the c/k/ck rule for /k/ at the end of words (see Main Programme TP 47 and TP48) by counting the number of syllables in each word. In one syllable words note if the /k/ sound is heard after a vowel or consonant.
