

CONQUERING LITERACY ACTIVITY 5: SENTENCE BUILDING SUFFIX 'S' (AP TP4)

A. Cut up the cards in the first grid (plural 's') and arrange them in three sets. Ask the learner to use one card of each colour to construct sentences and discuss if the noun is in agreement. B. Repeat the activity for the second grid and ask the learner to read the sentences back to ensure the verb agrees.

Mum has	six	sun hats
The dog has	a	bad leg
The man has	ten	big hens
Sam hits	a	tin can
I get	six	red cups

Dad	gets	a bin bag
Tom	pats	the dog
I	sit	on a log
Pat and Kim	tip it	in the pan
Mum	puts the buns	in a box

Ask the learner to write a sentence containing suffix 's' for a verb and suffix 's' for a plural noun.
