1. How do I access an Interactive eBook?

Navigate to the URL included in your slimpack and redeem the access code printed inside. **You must redeem your access code via Bookshelf Online or Bookshelf Desktop before you can download the eBook to your tablet or mobile device.**

Once you sign up for an account and redeem your access code, you can read the eBook online or download the eBook to your desktop, tablet or mobile device. To use the eBook on a device, you must first download the free Bookshelf app. [Click here for app download instructions.](#)







3. How do my students access the Interactive eBooks?


After they purchase the eBook, they will follow the same process as the instructor.

The eBook allows you to add notes, highlight the text and share notes and highlights. It includes a search tool as well as multimedia links accessible right from the book.

Using VitalSource Bookshelf's apps, you can read the text on your desktop, laptop, tablet and mobile device. You can also download the text to your device for offline reading.

10. Is there anything else I should know about the product?

You must redeem your access code via Bookshelf Online or Bookshelf Desktop before you can download the eBook to your tablet or mobile device. You cannot redeem an access code via your tablet or mobile device.

Students and instructors are able to print 30 pages of the Interactive eBook from VitalSource Bookshelf.
