**Object:** cover three in a row with your counters.

**Materials:** game board, two kinds of counters, special number cube or spinner (4-9)

**How to play:**

- 1 Player one rolls or spins to determine the amount to add to 19.
- 2 Player states the addition number sentence and places the counter on the answer.
- 3 The next player rolls or spins, adds, and places the counter on the answer.
- 4 If the sum is no longer available, player may spin or roll again.
- 5 Players take turns until one player has three counters in a row, horizontally, vertically or diagonally.
