**Object:** cover three in a row with your counters.

**Materials:** game board, two kinds of counters, special number cube or spinner (0–9)

**How to play:**

- 1 Roll the 0–9 number generator or spin the 0–9 spinner.
- 2 Subtract the number you rolled from 20. For example, if you roll a 6, subtract 20–6 and place your marker on 14.
- 3 Players alternate turns.
- 4 The winner is the first player to get three in a row, either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.
