How to play:

2 Player states the addition number sentence and places the counter on the answer.
3 The next player rolls or spins, adds, states the number sentence, and places the counter on the answer.
4 If the sum is no longer available, player may spin or roll again.
5 Players take turns until one player has three counters in a row, horizontally, vertically or diagonally.
