

How many more to make 100?

90	30	20	60	10
40	10	80	70	50
70	20	50	40	30
10	60	40	80	90
30	100	50	70	20

Object: cover three in a row with your counters.

Materials: game board, two kinds of counters, decuple spinner (0, 10, 20, 30 ... 90).

How to play:

- 1 Player spins to determine the starting amount. Player must determine how much more is needed to make 100.
- 2 Player states the addition number sentence and places the counter on missing addend.
- 3 The next player rolls or spins, determines the missing addend, and places the counter on the answer.
- 4 Players take turns until one player has three counters in a row.
