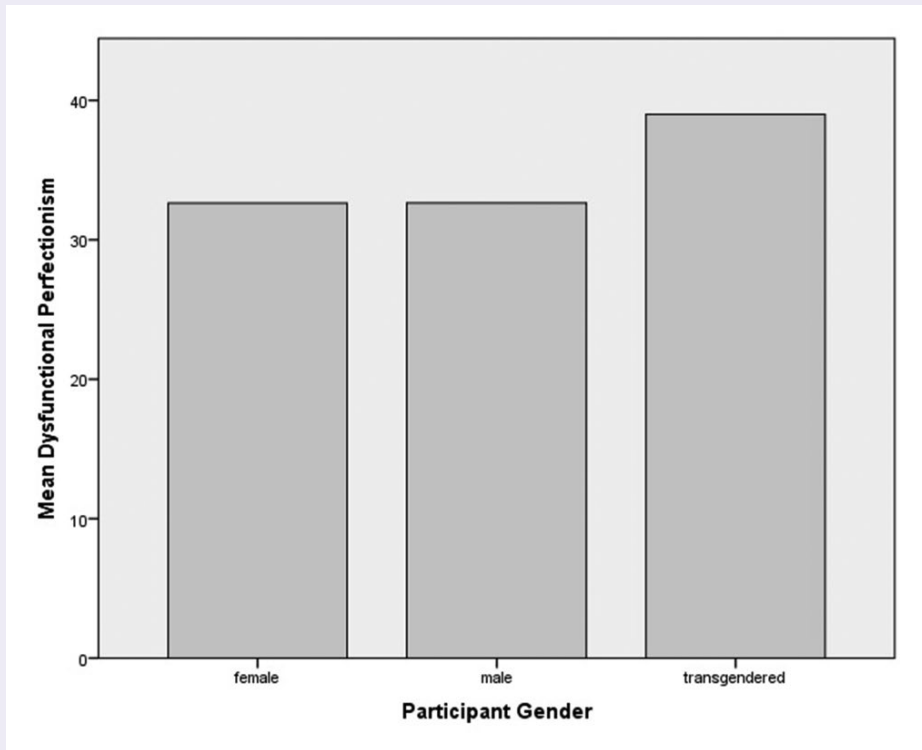


LEARNING CHECK

1. Use Wendt's (2013) data and in SPSS, make a bar graph to illustrate sex differences in dysfunctional perfectionism.

2. In the previous question, why would it not be appropriate to make a scatterplot to illustrate sex differences in dysfunctional perfectionism?

A: A person's sex is a nominal variable. That is, a person falls into one and only one category on this variable. A scatterplot is appropriate for scale data; bar graphs are appropriate for nominal data.
