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NARRATIVE

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INCIDENT NUMBER: 01-189023

OFFICER: S.M. BAIR #11511

ON 12/21/01 AT APPROXIMATELY 1819 HOURS, I WAS DISPATCHED TO SUZIE'S FABRICS, 19 TRIPP ST, GOTHAM, IN RESPONSE TO AN ARMED ROBBERY THAT JUST OCCURRED. ADDITIONAL PATROL UNITS BEGAN CIRCULATING THE AREA WHILE I RESPONDED TO THE STORE. AS I ENTERED THE STORE I WAS APPROACHED BY A SUBJECT, LATER IDENTIFIED AS JOHN BOYLE, WHO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS A WITNESS. BOYLE TOLD ME THE FOLLOWING.

BOYLE SAID HE WAS STANDING NEAR A DISPLAY SHELF APPROXIMATELY 15 FEET FROM THE CASH REGISTERS WHEN HE HEARD A SUBJECT SAY, "JUST DO IT!" BOYLE SAID THE STATEMENT CAUGHT HIS ATTENTION SO HE TURNED AND NOTICED THAT IT APPEARED THE STORE WAS BEING ROBBED. BOYLE WATCHED THE SUSPECT AS HE CONTINUED TO SPEAK WITH THE CLERK. HE OBSERVED THAT THE SUSPECT WAS A WHITE MALE, 33-38 YOA, 506-508, 160-180 LBS, SHOULDER LENGTH FRIZZY BROWN HAIR, DARK COLORED MUSTACHE, DARKED FRAMED GLASSES, WEARING A RED BASEBALL CAP, BLUE JEANS, AND A HEAVY BLUE JEAN JACKET.

BOYLE CONTINUED AND SAID HE ALSO HEARD THE SUSPECT SAY TO THE CASHIER, "I'M WOULDN'T BE DOING THIS." BOYLE TOLD ME HE WAS GOING TO ATTEMPT TO EXIT THE STORE TO GAIN A BETTER VANTAGE OF THE SUSPECT AND WHERE HE WOULD FLEE, BUT THAT AS HE THOUGHT THIS, THE SUSPECT BEGAN RUNNING TOWARD THE FRONT DOORS.

BOYLE WATCHED AS THE SUSPECT FLED OUT THE OPEN FRONT DOORS. HE EXITED THE STORE BEHIND THE SUSPECT AND WATCHED AS HE RAN WESTBOUND ALONG THE STORE FRONTS AND THEN SOUTH ON TRIPP AVE. BOYLE ENTERED HIS PERSONAL VEHICLE AND ATTEMPTED TO FOLLOW THE SUSPECT, HOWEVER, HE SAID THAT HE WAS GONE WHEN HE TURNED ONTO TRIPP.

BOYLE STATED HE DID NOT SEE A WEAPON USED DURING THE INCIDENT AND THAT HE WAS ONLY ABLE TO SEE "THE PROFILE" OF THE SUSPECT. BOYLE CAN IDENTIFY THE SUSPECT IF SEEN AGAIN AND IS WILLING TO AID IN PROSECUTION. BOYLE ADDED THAT HE IS A GOTHAM POLICE OFFICER.

I THEN CONTACTED THE STORE MANAGER, SUZANNA KIMBALL. KIMBALL SAID SHE WAS PRESENT WHEN SHE SAW THE SUSPECT ENTER THE STORE BUT THAT SHE WAS CALLED AWAY BY ANOTHER CUSTOMER. KIMBALL DESCRIBED THE SUSPECT AS A WHITE MALE, 30-40 YOA, 506, THIN BUILD, SHOULDER LENGTH CURLY BLACK HAIR PEPPERED WITH GREY, UNKNOWN FACIAL HAIR, WEARING A DARK COLORED BASEBALL CAP, HEAVY DENIM JACKET, AND PANTS. KIMBALL DISTINCTLY NOTED THAT THE SUSPECT WAS WEARING THICK RIMMED BLACK PRESCRIPTION GLASSES. I ASKED WHY SHE THOUGHT THE GLASSES WERE PRESCRIPTION. KIMBALL TOLD ME THAT THE SUSPECTS EYES AND FACE BENEATH THE LENS APPEARED DISTORTED DUE TO THE STRENGTH OF THE PRESCRIPTION.

KIMBALL CONTINUED AND STATED THE CUSTOMER SHE WAS ASSISTING WAS VERY INSISTENT ON KIMBALL HELPING HER. KIMBALL THOUGHT THAT THE CUSTOMER WAS ATTEMPTING TO "DISTRACT" HER WHILE THE STORE WAS BEING ROBBED. KIMBALL SAID AFTER IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE STORE HAD BEEN ROBBED, THE CUSTOMER RUSHED TO BE CHECKED OUT, ACTUALLY ASKING IF SHE COULD BE CHECKED OUT AHEAD OF OTHER CUSTOMERS. KIMBALL ADDED THAT THE CUSTOMER HAD TWO SMALL CHILDREN WITH HER AND THAT SHE WAS IN THE STORE PRIOR TO THE SUSPECT ENTERING. THE CUSTOMER EXITED THE STORE MOMENTS AFTER THE ROBBERY OCCURRED. SHE USED A VISA CREDIT CARD (#445208222222284) TO MAKE HER PURCHASES. A COPY OF THE CREDIT CARD

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RECEIPT WAS TAKEN AND IMPOUNDED AS EVIDENCE AT THE GOTHAM POLICE DEPARTMENT, 1234 E MAIN ST, GOTHAM.

THE CREDIT CARD RECEIPT IS DATED 12/21/01 AND TIME STAMPED AT 1818 HOURS. THERE IS NO CARDHOLDER INFORMATION ON THE RECEIPT. THE VISA CREDIT CARD PHONE NUMBER LISTED ON THE RECEIPT IS 1-800-123-4567. THE RECEIPT WAS FOR A PURCHASE OF \$17.98 IN GOODS. THE CUSTOMER'S SIGNATURE ON THE RECEIPT IS ILLEGIBLE. IT IS UNKNOWN WHETHER OR NOT THE CUSTOMER WAS INSTRUMENTAL OR RELEVANT TO THE ROBBERY; HOWEVER, IT IS BEING MENTIONED AS PART OF THE INCIDENT. KIMBALL DID NOT SEE THE SUSPECT DURING OR AFTER THE INCIDENT DUE TO HER HELPING THE OTHER CUSTOMER.

KIMBALL CAN IDENTIFY THE SUSPECT IF SEEN AGAIN AND IS WILLING TO AID IN PROSECUTION.

I THEN CONTACTED A CUSTOMER WHO HAD BEEN IN THE STORE AT THE TIME OF THE ROBBERY. SHE IDENTIFIED HERSELF AS JUDY PRICE. PRICE RELAYED THE FOLLOWING. PRICE STATED SHE WAS BROWSING THROUGH THE DISPLAY AISLES APPROXIMATELY 30 FEET TO THE EAST OF THE CASH REGISTERS. SHE HEARD THE CASHIER, LATER IDENTIFIED AS AMBER BROWN, EXCLAIM "HE TOOK THE MONEY!" PRICE TURNED AND NOTICED A SUBJECT WALKING TOWARD THE FRONT DOORS. SHE DESCRIBED HIM AS A WHITE MALE, 17-20 YOA, 511, 140 LBS, SHORT DIRTY BLONDE HAIR, WEARING A TAN JACKET, AND BLUE JEANS. SHE COULD NOT SEE THE SUBJECTS FACE AS HIS BACK WAS TURNED TOWARD HER. SHE ADDED THAT THE SUBJECT EXITED THE STORE AND CONTINUED WALKING WESTBOUND. PRICE COULD NOT PROVIDE ANY FURTHER DETAILS REGARDING THE INCIDENT AND STATED THAT SHE ONLY SAW HIM FROM BEHIND. PRICE CANNOT IDENTIFY THE SUBJECT IS SEEN AGAIN BUT IS WILLING TO AID IN PROSECUTION.

I THEN CONTACTED THE CASHIER, AMBER BROWN. BROWN STATED THAT SHE WAS WORKING THE CASH REGISTER THAT EVENING AT SUZIE'S FABRIC. AT APPROXIMATELY 1810 HOURS, SHE SAID THAT SHE NOTICED A SUBJECT STANDING NEAR THE BOOKSTAND 8-10 FEET JUST NORTH OF THE CASH REGISTERS. THE SUBJECT WAS "ACTING ODD" AND "APPEARED TO BE DUCKING BEHIND THE BOOKSTAND." WHEN THE SUBJECT NOTICED THAT BROWN HAD NOTICED HIM, HE THEN APPROACHED THE CHECKOUT COUNTER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE CASH REGISTERS. HE IMMEDIATELY WITHDREW A BLACK SEMI-AUTOMATIC HANDGUN USING HIS LEFT HAND FROM THE INSIDE OF HIS COAT AND DISPLAYED IT TO BROWN. BROWN STATED THE SUSPECT DID NOT POINT THE HANDGUN AT HER, BUT DISPLAYED IT SEVERAL TIMES DURING THE COURSE OF THE ROBBERY.

BROWN DESCRIBED THE SUSPECT AS A WHITE MALE, 30 YOA, 507-508, MEDIUM BUILD, CURLY SANDY BROWN COLLAR LENGTH HAIR, BLACK ROUND FRAMED PRESCRIPTION GLASSES, AND UNSHAVEN. BROWN SAID HE WAS WEARING A HEAVY DENIM JACKET WITH A BROWN CORDUROY COLLAR, BLUE JEANS, AND WAS UNSURE IF HE WAS WEARING A HAT.

BROWN DESCRIBED THE GUN AS A BLACK SEMI-AUTOMATIC HANDGUN, SIMILAR TO THE HANDGUN I CARRY (A GLOCK MODEL 22.) SHE SAID SHE DID NOT SEE A HAMMER ON THE WEAPON AND THOUGHT THAT IT "DIDN'T LOOK REAL."

BROWN CONTINUED AND SAID THAT AFTER THE SUSPECT DREW THE HANDGUN, HE SAID TO HER "OPEN THE DRAWER." BROWN RESPONDED "I CAN'T, YOU HAVE TO BUY SOMETHING." THE SUSPECT THEN SAID, "I'M SERIOUS, I'M DESPERATE AND WOULDN'T BE DOING THIS UNLESS I WAS DESPERATE." BROWN SAID SHE WAS STALLING AND CONTINUED TO TELL THE SUSPECT THAT HE HAD TO BUY SOMETHING IN ORDER TO GET

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THE CASH REGISTER OPEN. THE SUSPECT THEN SAID, "I'LL SHOOT YOU." BROWN TOLD THE SUSPECT "I DON'T BELIEVE YOU." HE REPLIED "YOU'RE PISSING ME OFF." THE SUSPECT THEN GRABBED AN ITEM OF ROPE FROM NEAR THE CASH REGISTER AND HANDED IT TO BROWN TO SCAN FOR PURCHASE. BROWN SCANNED THE ITEM, OPENED THE REGISTER, AND HANDED THE SUSPECT A STACK OF MONEY (LATER DETERMINED TO BE \$186 IN MISCELLANEOUS DENOMINATIONS.) BROWN COULD NOT RECALL IF THE SUSPECT REACHED OVER THE COUNTER TO REMOVE ANY OF THE MONEY BUT STATED HE MUST HAVE BECAUSE SHE ONLY REMEMBERED GIVING HIM ONE STACK OF MONEY AND THAT SEVERAL STACKS WERE TAKEN. THE SUSPECT THEN TOOK THE MONEY AND RAN OUT THE FRONT DOORS AND PROCEEDED WESTBOUND ALONG THE STORE FRONTS.

BROWN SAID SHE CAN IDENTIFY THE SUSPECT IF SEEN AGAIN AND IS WILLING TO AID IN PROSECUTION. BROWN ADDED THAT EVEN THOUGH SHE THOUGHT THE GUN WAS NOT REAL INITIALLY, AS THE ROBBERY PROGRESSED, SHE BEGAN TO FEAR FOR HER LIFE.

CARE 9 SERVICES WERE OFFERED TO ALL PERSONS, HOWEVER, EVERYONE DECLINED.

THE AREA WAS DUSTED FOR PRINTS AND THREE LATENT PRINT CARDS WERE OBTAINED FROM THE COUNTER TOP WHERE THE SUSPECT WAS STANDING. THEY WERE FORWARDED TO THE ID BUREAU FOR ANALYSIS. NO OTHER PHYSICAL EVIDENCE WAS OBTAINED.

A COPY OF THE CASH REGISTER RECEIPT BELONGING TO THE CUSTOMER KIMBALL WAS ASSISTING WAS TAKEN AND IMPOUNDED AS EVIDENCE AT THE GOTHAM POLICE DEPARTMENT 1234 E MAIN ST, GOTHAM, LOCKER #9.

SUZIE'S FABRICS WAS PROVIDED WITH A VICTIM RIGHTS PAMPHLET AND A REPRESENTATIVE STATED THEY WOULD BE WILLING TO AID IN PROSECUTION.

A CHECK OF THE SURROUNDING AREA MET WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.

THERE ARE NO SUSPECTS OR INVESTIGATIVE LEADS.
